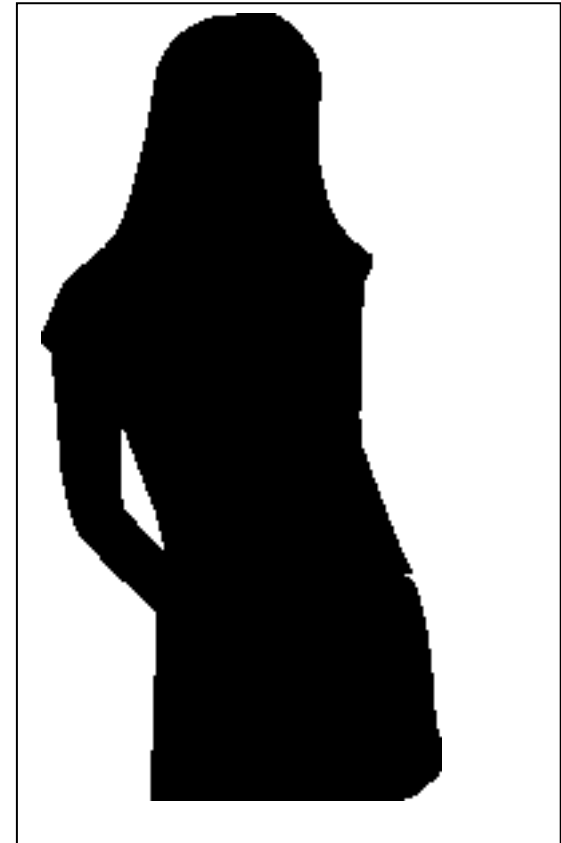


Her partner is always suggesting that they do things that they've seen in porn. She is 16 and her partner is 19.

**What should he have done differently?**

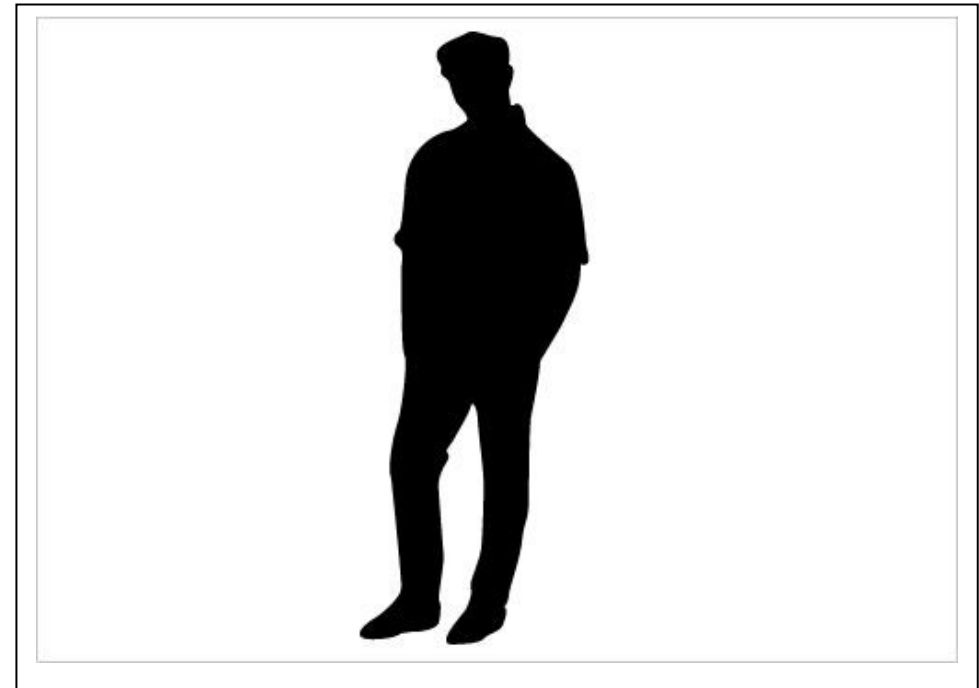
**Where could she go for help and support?**

**How might he be feeling?**

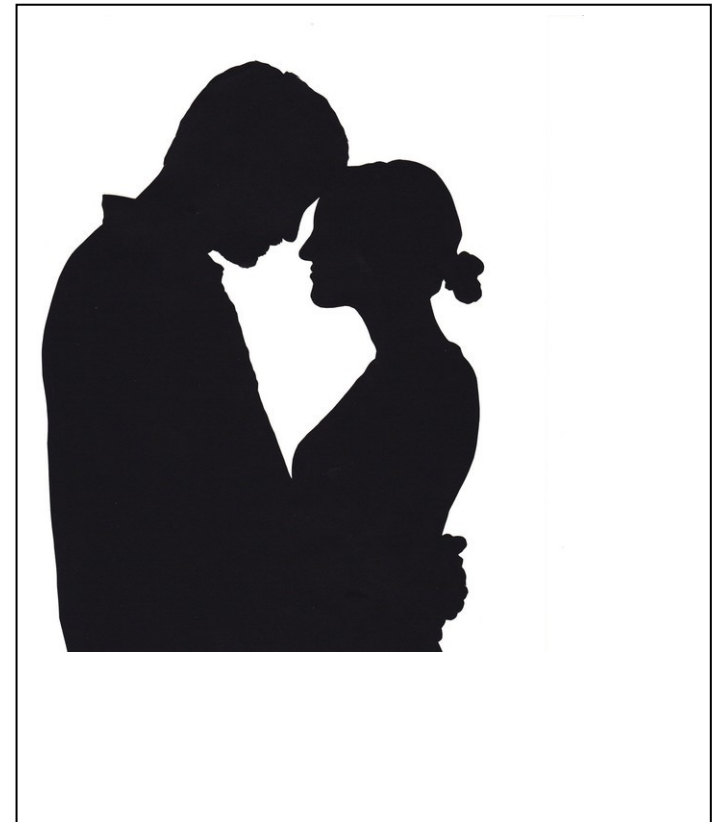
**Why might someone decide not to have sex?**

**What could happen next?**

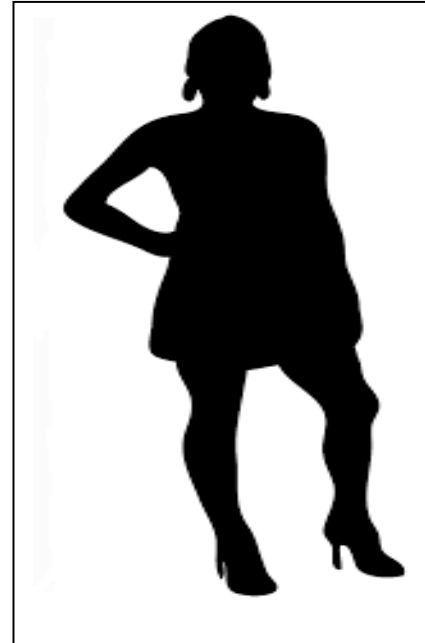
**How could you prevent a similar situation happening?**

**What do you think of her?**

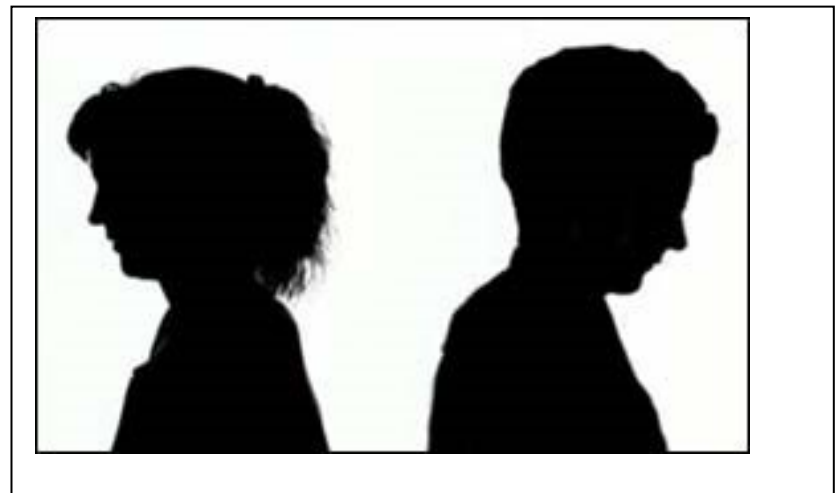
**Do you think she could attract the wrong kind of attention or get herself in to trouble in any way?**
